Job Summary:

The Field Trainer for Agriculture Livelihoods & Resilience (AL&R) is responsible for ensuring that producer group member participants have the capacity and support needed to ensure continued improved production practices that enhance production, income and savings. S/he will monitor progress at group level and work with the TO-AL&R to prescribe remedial actions. S/he will be assigned to a number of villages in a union and will engage directly with the group leaders and at times may need to deal with the community as directed by the TO-(AL&R). Directly interacts with the village level community groups to offer training and support in areas identified as needing support Supports the grading exercise for producer groups and farmer leaders Develop capacity of the farmer leaders through training and on the job capacity building Visit and support once in a month to each producer group and mobilize farmer leaders (FL) for active support to producer groups and stimulate their income Help the group to identify specific areas in agriculture and livestock that need reinforcement Communicate the gaps TO AL&R and supports in the designing of group specific content for training Based on grading level of specific group and farmer leaders, visits the group every 2 weeks, monthly or, quarterly defined through the assessment Identify the service gaps at the producer groups and inform TO AL&R for advice and action Monitors progress in group on agriculture and livestock areas and recommends remedial action to the TO AL&R Engages with producer groups to identify specific progress/gaps in practicing improved technologies and adoption of risk reduction actions Supports farmer leaders with appropriate content for reinforcing messages/ making connections to help address the identified gaps. Participates in union level program team coordination and planning event to ensure that groups are supported in a coherent manner. Be present in monthly work planning with TOs for all FTs Work closely with FT O_LH&FI Ensure collaborative approach with other technical FTs Support as appropriate the work of other FTs. Reports on monthly basis on key activities implemented each month to the TO using provided formats and tools Engages with the union level staffs of DAE, DoL, DoF, Vaccinators, and other private actors to identify and troubleshoot for gaps in service provision Form Village Entrepreneurs Forum and Union Entrepreneurs Forum with support from FT O_LH&FI, facilitate and follow up their meeting as well as inform TO about the critical findings of those meetings Supports in setting of Micro Seed Retailer, input seller and developing vaccinators and other service providers with technical and logistical issues as may arise ensuring community level required services.
