Job Summary:

The field trainer for HHN&WE is responsible for ensuring that program participant groups have the capacity and support needed to ensure continued practice of behaviors that enhance increase nutrition, health and women empowerment in the communities. She will monitor progress at group level and work with them TO HHN&WE to prescribe remedial actions. She will be assigned to a number of villages in a union and will engage directly with the group leaders and at times may need to deal with the community as directed by the TO HHN&WE. Directly interacts with the village level community groups to offer training and support in areas identified as needing support Supports the grading exercise for producer and youth groups Helps the group to identify specific areas in WE and HHN that need reinforcement Communicates the gaps to HHN/WE TO and supports in the designing of group specific content for training Based on grading level of specific group, visits the group every 2 weeks, monthly or, quarterly defined through the assessment. Monitors progress in group on HHN/WE areas and recommends remedial action to the TO HHN/WE Engages with PLW and other community members to identify specific progress/gaps in practicing prioritized behaviors Supports group leaders with appropriate content for reinforcing messages/ making connections to help address the identified behavior gaps. Participates in union level program team coordination and planning events to ensure that groups are supported in a coherent manner. Be present in monthly work planning with TOs for all FTs Ensure collaborative approach with other technical FTs Support as appropriate the work of other FTs. Supports Community Health Workers in preparing for distribution point messaging for PLW Help the CHW define messages Attend one FDP once a month to support the Cowheel resolve challenges faced by PLW in food distribution and make referrals to the TO HHN/WE Reports on monthly basis on key activities implemented each month to the TO using provided formats and tools Engages with Community Clinic, Satellite Clinic, EPI Center and other private actors to identify and troubleshoot for gaps in service provision Supports GMP service providers with technical and logistical issues as may arise ensuring continuing engagement for referral, counseling and GMP services. Support the community in the CLTS process.
